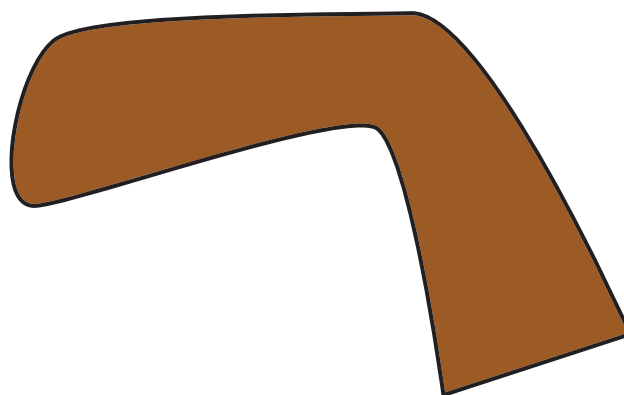
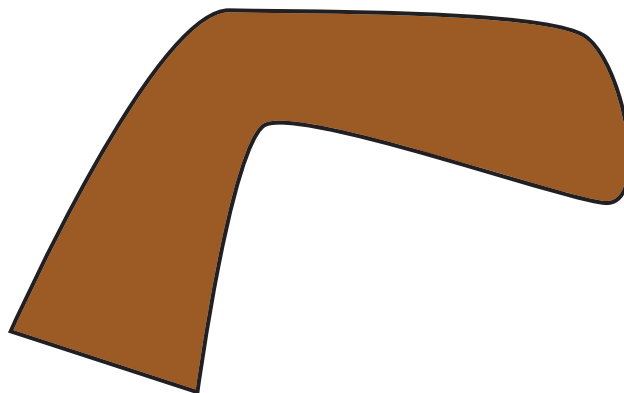
Just a Quick Check: This little square should be exactly 1 inch. It's not part of the craft—just here to make sure your printer isn't playing tricks and everything prints at the right size!
