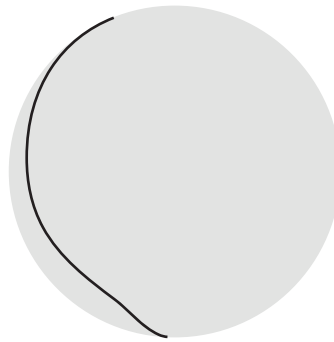
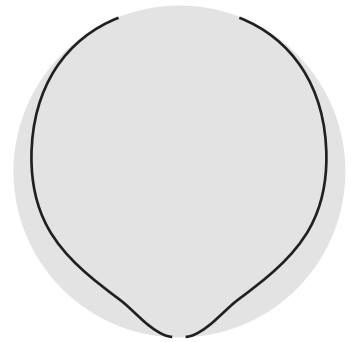


# Paper Plate Acorn

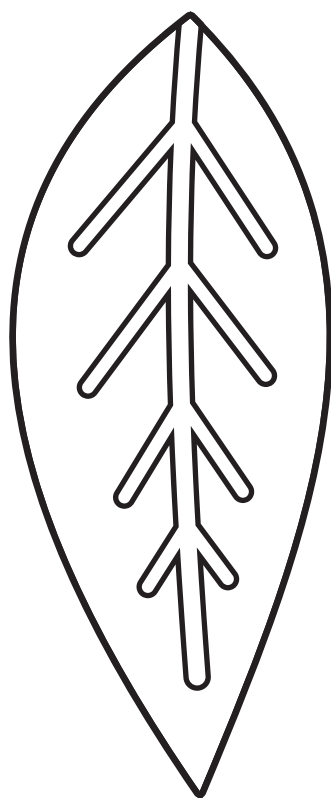
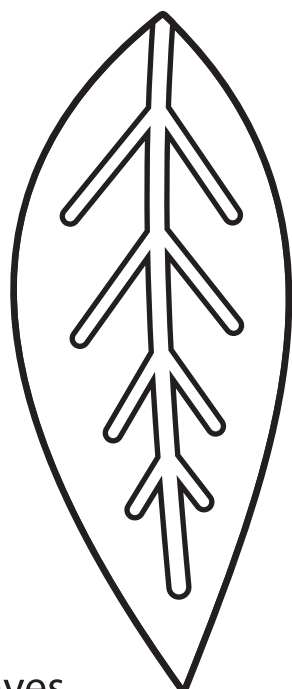
The eyebrows may be tricky to cut: feel free to draw them on with a marker instead!

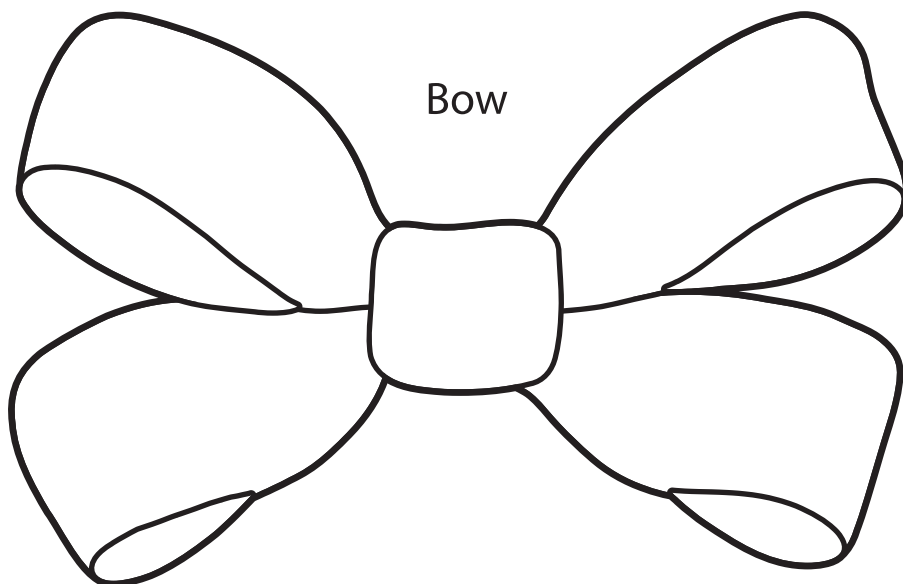

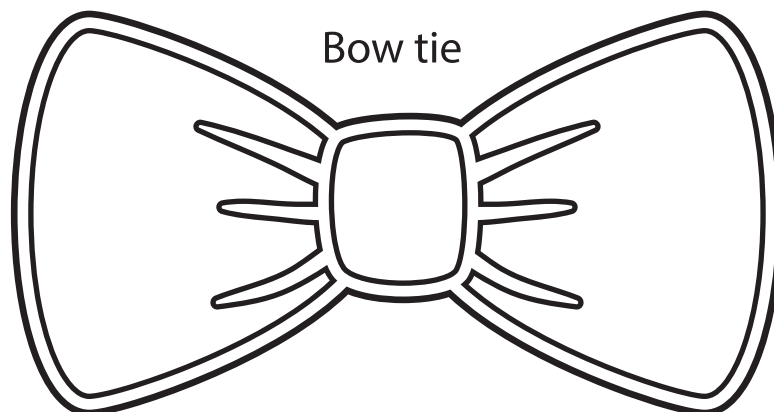
