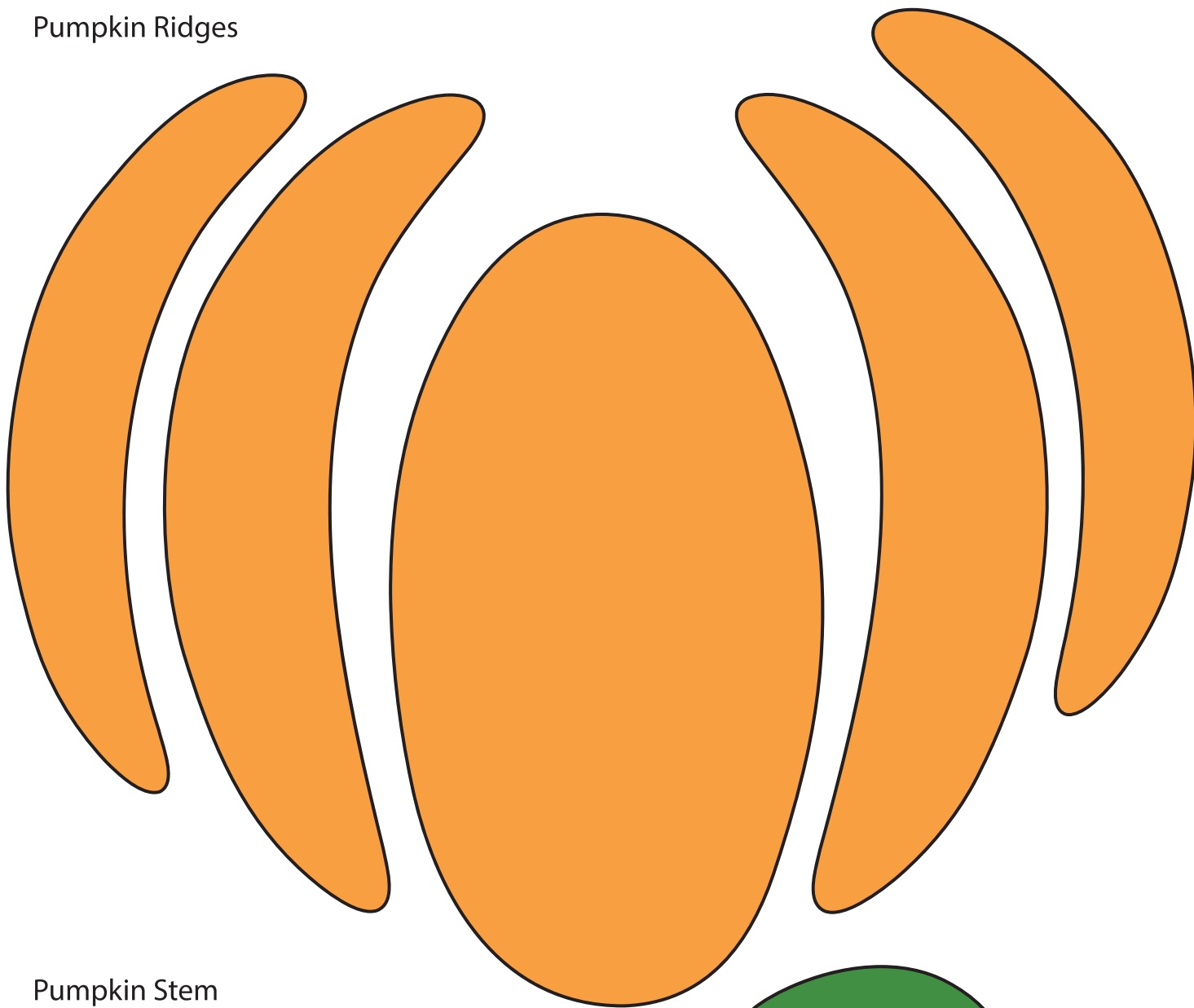
To shape your pumpkin: Cut out the curved line on this page to use as a tracing guide. Place it on the top edge of a paper plate as shown in template and trace the curve. Then flip the guide and trace it on the bottom. Cut along both traced lines to form your pumpkin!

Eyebrows



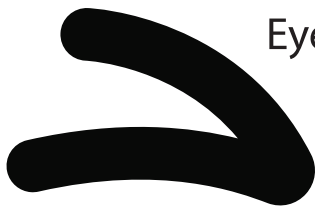
The eyebrows may be tricky to cut: feel free to draw them on with a marker instead!

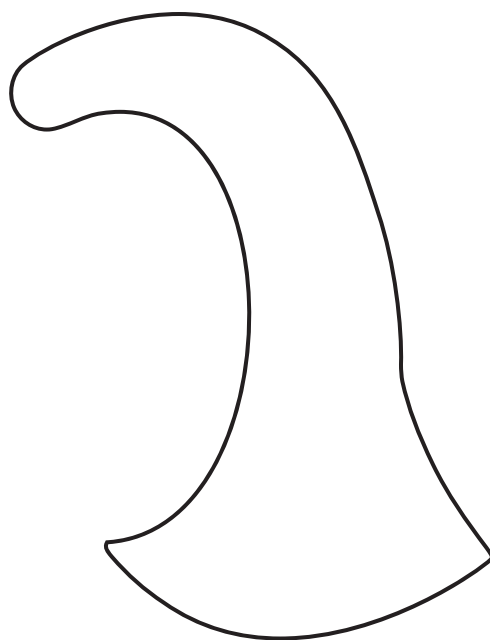
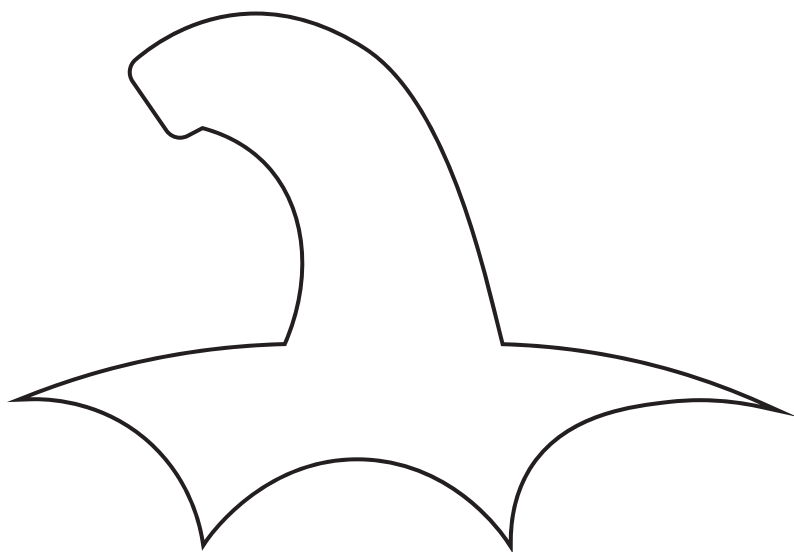
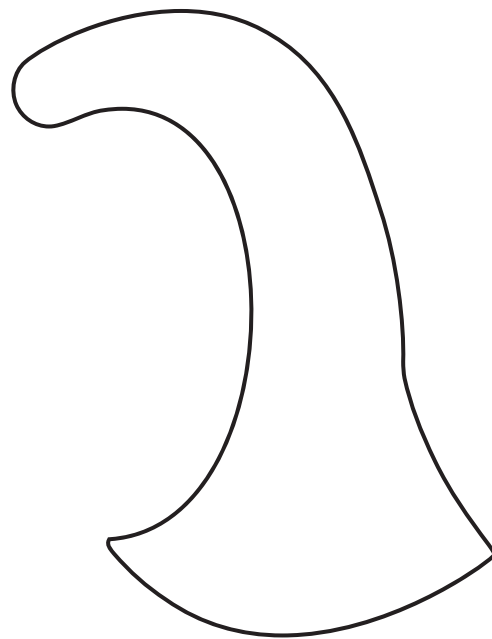
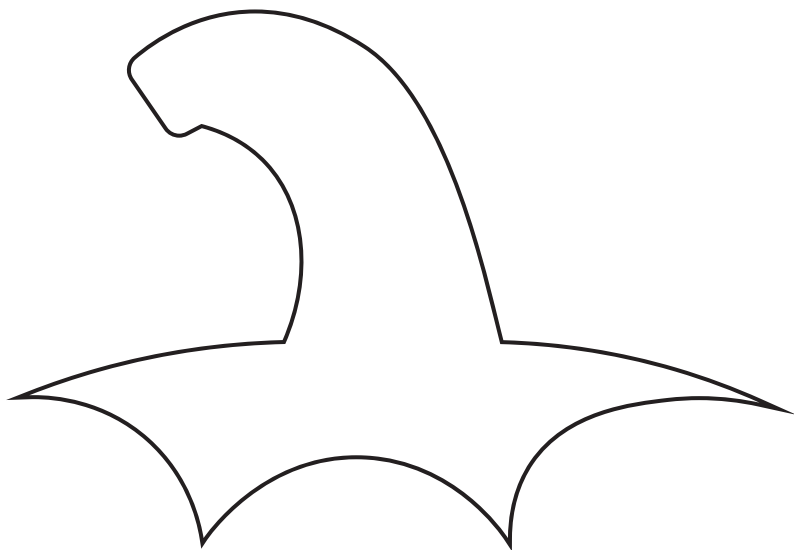
Tip: print on orange or green paper, or use as a tracing template to save ink!
