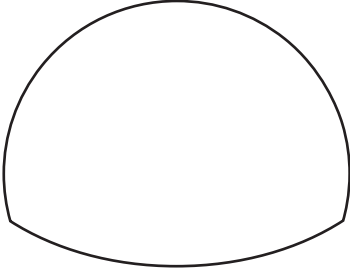
1. Start with paper plate



2. Trace the lady bug body and cut it out.

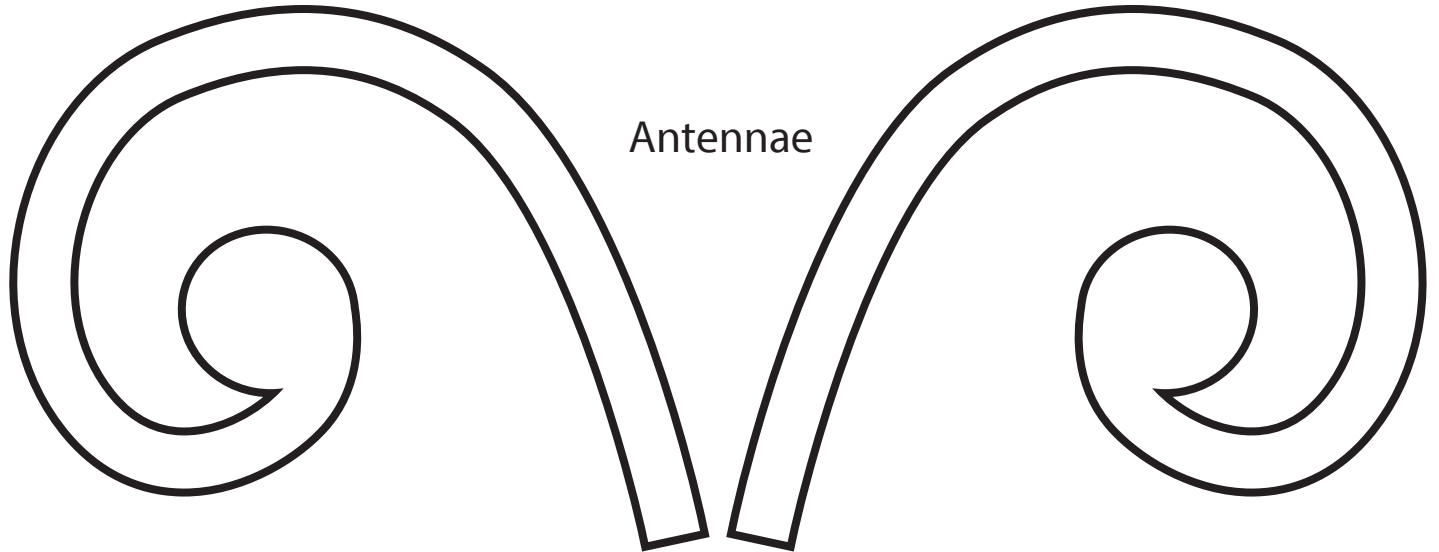
