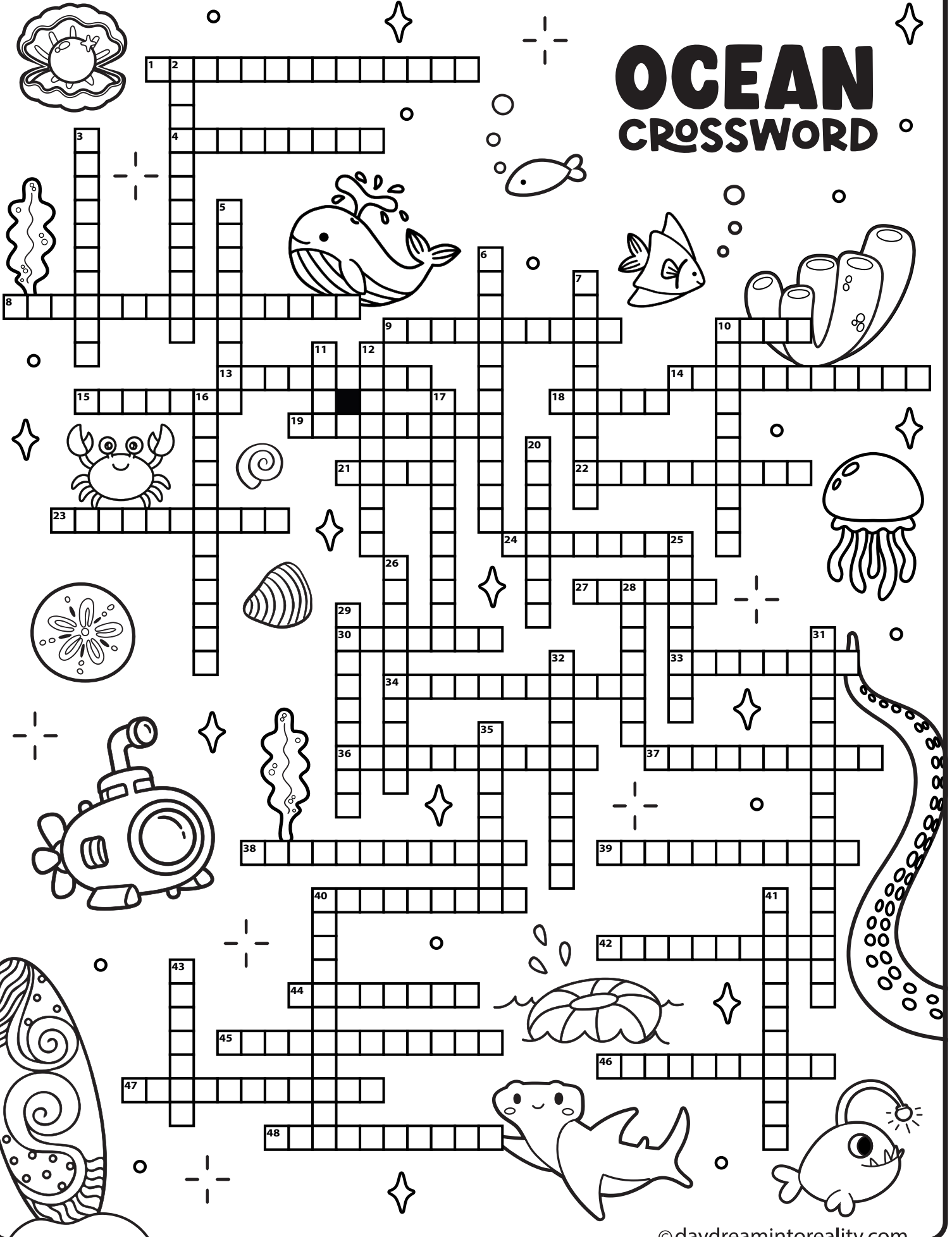


OCEAN CROSSWORD



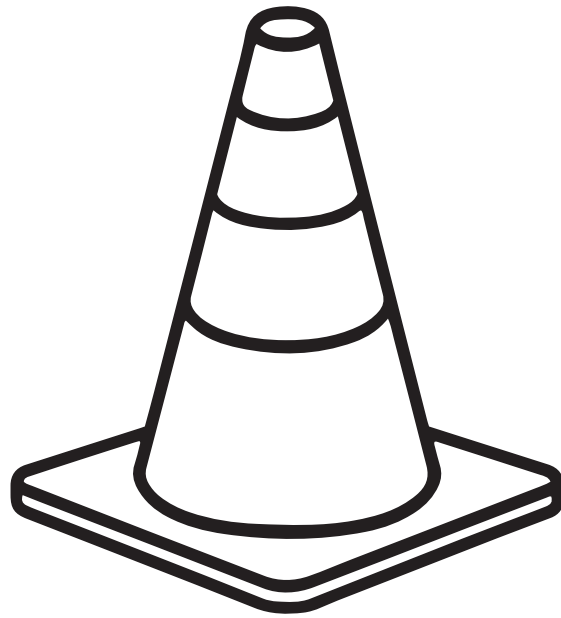
ACROSS

14. Tiny drifting creatures that become food for many larger marine animals.
15. Rocky hiding place where waves enter and echo.
18. Forms a ring of coral islands around a peaceful central lagoon.
19. Highest point of a wave before it breaks.
21. Luxurious boat designed for sailing adventures and relaxation.
22. Beach find known for the star-shaped design on its shell.
23. Gemstone whose name and color come from the sea.
24. Underwater peak rising high above the seafloor.
27. Filters water and sometimes creates valuable pearls inside its shell.
